## Music Festival 2025 Percussion Syllabus

#### **Percussion**

### **Concert Group (Any Percussion Instrument)**

Own choice of three selections

Performance will be judged on discrimination of selection which should be from standard concert or suitable instrument-specific literature, on group arrangement, contrast, appropriateness, keys, technique, interpretation, and stage presence.

- More than one percussion instrument may be used, i.e. tympani in one piece, marimba in another. All works must be bona fide percussion compositions.
- Concert pieces mostly consist of rhythmic challenges with the use of dynamics and colour contrasts. (ex. using brushes, mallets or snare-off or using rims and stick shots.)
- Rudiment pieces mostly consist of rudiments and rhythmic challenges with different types of rolls, diddles, flam, and drag rudiments.
- Performance from memory is encouraged but not mandatory for percussion concert group classes.
- Selections must be performed as a set, one following the other without interruption. This applies to all concert group classes
- Penalty for abuse of time limit
- Competitors must not perform any selection entered in any other class in the current festival
- Selections and performance time should be specified at registration

Competitors must not include in this class any selection from another class in which they are entered in the current festival. Selections and performance time should be specified at registration. Penalty for abuse of time limit. 90000 - Senior - 18 Years & Over  Own choice of three selections Performance from memory is mandatory Time Limit: 30 minutes  Performance will be judged on discrimination of selection which should be from standard concert or suitable instrument-specific literature, on group arrangement, contrast, appropriateness, keys, technique, interpretation, and stage presence. Competitors must not include in this class any selection from another class in which they are entered in the current festival. Selections and performance time should be specified at registration. Penalty for abuse of time limit.  In order to proceed to the Senior Instrumental Rose Bowl Competition, competitors must be recommended by the adjudicator and must have received a mark of at least 85.	\$55.00	n/a

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### **Sonata (Any Percussion Instrument)**

Own choice of one percussion sonata.

- Must be a sonata written originally for percussion and piano
- Participants must supply original music for the adjudicator
- Selection and performance time should be specified at registration

- Must supply original music to the adjudicator
- Selection and performance time should be specified at registration
